During the day you can participate in the various sporting activities available, enjoy a swim or just relax in the sauna.

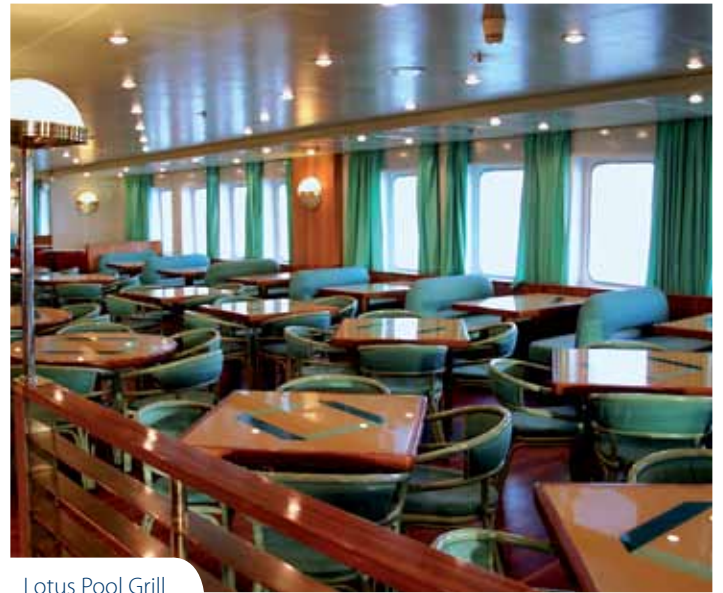

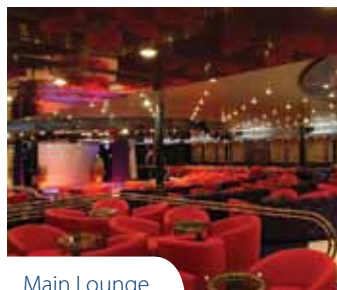
